

## MMA POKER RUN RULES

The MMA Poker Run is not a competitive event or a race! The MMA Poker Run is a fun way to bring our members together and enjoy our park trails...with some food and prizes of course!

**What is a Poker Run?** A Poker Run is a number of stations setup around the park in various spots. Each station is a SECRET and only staff knows of their location. Each station has its own colored poker chip that each rider must collect in a certain amount of time. Once Poker Chips are collected they must be brought to the Dealers Tent and traded for playing cards. Each rider will make a 5 card poker hand with the Poker Chips collected. The rider with the best hand wins! Of course, we have some exceptions to the rules during our MMA Poker Run!

**MMA POKER RUN...** During the start of the MMA Poker Run each rider will receive a Cheat Sheet with hints, tips, and puzzles to help them find each station. The stations can be anywhere in the park and can be located on any portion of a trail. Riders will have 4 hours to collect all seven of their colored chips and return them to the Dealer Tent. Only a total of 5 chips are required to complete the 5 card poker hand. The MMA Poker Run has 7 SECRET stations for every rider to find. The first 5 stations are numbered 1-5, have a specific chip color, and have a particular closing time. In addition to these 5 stations will be 2 Dirt Bike Only stations and 2 ATV Only stations. These additional stops will increase the rider's chances of a better 5 card poker hand. Each station has a corresponding 52 card deck that the MMA Dealer maintains at the Dealers Tent. The only way to get a card from the dealer's deck is to have a colored coin from that decks station. Upon finding a station the riders must pickup and keep ONE colored chip that will be returned to the Dealers Tent in exchange for a card. If time allows collect all seven colored coins and return them to the dealer to make a 5 card poker hand. Some stations may be hard to find and some riders may want to DRAW for a better hand. This is why the MMA Poker Run allows a little Dealer Bribery. Each rider is allowed one cheat. If you need help finding a location or want to draw a card then come back to the Dealers Tent. You will be given a task to complete that will be chosen by the dealer. Once a rider completes their Poker Run by collecting enough chips to make a 5 card poker hand they must return to the Dealers Tent for chip exchange. The rider must make the best possible hand with 5 of the 7 possible cards. Each rider's best poker hand will be recorded by the Dealer and the rider with the best poker hand wins the grand prize! Prizes will be awarded to riders from highest to lowest hands. In the event of a tie cards will be drawn and the high card wins!

  - STATION 5 CLOSES: 5:00 p.m.
  - 2 ADDITIONAL ATV AND 2 ADDITIONAL DIRT BIKE STATIONS CLOSES: 5:00 P.M.
- WILD CARDS:
  - JOKERS: 4 jokers will be mixed into the 7 decks of cards. Each joker will be worth a draw of your choice.
  - ACE OF SPADES! Ace of Spades will be worth a free two card draw.
